

Multinational Association of Supportive Care in Cancer (MASCC)

Policy regarding Press Conferences and Press Releases during the MASCC
International Symposia

Press conferences may take place during the MASCC International Symposia regarding information presented at the meeting with the following provisions:

- 1) Press conference can take place regarding information to be presented at the MASCC meeting even if the data haven't been presented at the MASCC scientific session. The removal of an embargo is valid for 2014, and if not rescinded then also for following years.
- 2) A press conference cannot occur during the MASCC scientific sessions or MASCC-endorsed satellite symposia.
- 3) In no way can the press conference appear to be sponsored or endorsed by MASCC.
- 4) Those holding a press conference are responsible for obtaining their own space and facilities; however, the sponsors of the press conference are encouraged to work with the MASCC meeting planner regarding space and facilities.
- 5) Press releases: The press release review policy has been changed from 6 weeks in advance to 2 weeks, with special consideration for last minute reviews.
